#### Available Scholarships:

Aiming Forward College Foundation will be awarding three recipients for the 2022-2023 school year.

#### Application for this stipend requires submission of the following documents:

- Proof of residency in South Los Angeles área, Lynwood, Paramount, Compton, Watts, Lennox, Inglewood, Hawthorne, Carson, Wilmington, and Long Beach.
- Must be enrolled in a distinguished U.S. university for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Three Letters of recommendation from any school staff that has knowledge of your academic achievement, an employer, a coach, or a community member that has knowledge of your commitment to finishing your studies.
- Involvement in extracurricular activities.
- Financial aid award letter for 2022-2023 school year.
- Head of household 2021 income tax.
- Total household members, number of siblings, and ages.
- University acceptance letter and proof of enrollment.
- Answer question number 14 and attach essay.
